A RESOLUTION TO: TO ALLOCATE UP TO \$5,000 FROM THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT FINANCIAL RESERVES TO
SUBSIDIZE STUDENT ENROLLMENT FEES FOR RAPE AGRESSION DEFENSE COURSES.

THE STUDENT BODY OF EASTERN MICHIGAN UNIVERSITY ENACTS:

WHEREAS, campus safety is of great concern and consequence to the student body,

WHEREAS, Rape Agression Defense (RAD) can be a valuable tool in helping students to defend themselves
against sexual violence,

WHEREAS, students were most recently charged \$25 for Rec/IM members and \$30 for non-Rec/IM
members to take courses offered on RAD at the REC/IM,

WHEREAS, it is ideal for there to be no financial barrier to taking RAD courses,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Student Government allocates \$5,000 from its reserves for the purposes of
subsiding the entire cost for students taking Rape Agression Defense courses at the REC/IM. Any of
this funding not expended by the end of this school year will be allocated for the same purpose next
school year. Any unspent by the end of the next school year will be returned to the Eastern Michigan
University Student Government's reserves.




