Executive Order

Executive Order: 104-02
Effective Date: May 11th, 2017

Senate Resolution 100-006 established the Energy and Sustainability Committee in 2013. This committee was charged with researching and implementing environmentally friendly initiatives on behalf of the student body. Last calendar year, Executive Order 103-02 followed Order's 101-02 and 102-02 and re-established the Energy and Sustainability Commission for another academic year. Executive Order 103-02 set the Commission to conclude on April 26, 2017.

Recognizing the importance of this Commission, I hereby extend the Energy and Sustainability Commission until April 2018, upon which it may be dissolved.

The composition of the Commission shall be:

- Director of Sustainability, serving as Chair
- Three Senators appointed by the Senate, one serving as Vice-Chair
- Any student in good standing as determined by the Eastern Michigan University Department of Student Affairs

The Commission, with consultation from the Student Body President, Vice-President, and the Director of Sustainability, shall set a public meeting schedule.

The Senate will be regularly updated on the proceedings of the Commission. All meetings will be open to the public and Student Government members are encouraged to attend.

This Commission may be dissolved prior to the expiration of this Executive Order but shall require a two-thirds vote of the Senate.
