Executive Order

Executive Order: 103-06
Effective Date: April 24th, 2017

Student Government dedicates itself to the active role that our over 300 Student Organizations and Club Sports teams take on behalf of Eastern Michigan University. To ensure their success, Student Government sets aside over \$100,000 of its budget each year for allocations designated to Student Organizations and Club Sports whom apply and meet all qualifications to receive funds.

Student Government's FY17 Budget designates \$50,000 for Club Sports allocations. While we recognize that our system for allocating funds to Club Sports is not perfect, we have made several strides over the past several years to ensure Club Sports receive funds in a fair manner.

This Executive Order hereby requires that until April of 2020, Student Government dedicates funds in a line item of each year's Fiscal Year Budget for Club Sports allocations. This also requires that all funds allocated from each year's Fiscal Year budget to Club Sports must be allocated through the Business and Finance Committee and done so on an individual basis for each Club Sport requesting funds. No funds may be given to those who oversee Club Sports to conduct their own allocation procedures.

This is to ensure the proper distribution of these funds. While we do not accuse all those who oversee club sports as being biased towards specific clubs, we do recognize that bias is an issue at the departmental level.

We deem it as a negative action against students to allow Club Sports to distribute funds on Student Government's behalf. These funds are generated by the students themselves and should not simply be handed off to those who oversee club sports. It is our duty as the representatives of students to spend their funds in a manner that does not discriminate upon specific organizations or clubs.

This Executive Order may only be rescinded by an absolute two-thirds vote of the Senate.
