Executive Order: 103-05
Effective Date: November 22nd, 2016

The mission of Student Government is to give every student an effective voice in what happens at the University Administration level and beyond. In order to accomplish this, Executive Board members as well as Senators and Delegates are forced to take on a heavy workload. Recognizing the importance of professional workspace and the sometimes overworked status of the Executive Board, it has become an apparent need for Senators to have access to office computers, during times in which the Executive Board is present in the Office. Considering that all but one computer, referred to as Workstation #9, in the Office is used by Executive Board members, I hereby authorize the use of Workstation #9 for Student Body Senators.


This action is not intended to reinstitute the Senator Office hours which existed several years ago in order to expand the duties of Senators, which did not succeed in that task, but is intended to provide Senators with an office computer.

Senators shall be permitted to use Workstation #9, during hours in which Executive Board members are present to maintain the safety and security of the office, and must conduct themselves according to the Office Policies and additional procedures set forth by the Executive Board. These additional procedures will be posted in the office.

Senators will be respectful of other Senators who request the use of the station. In order to increase the access of this station to all Senators, any previous agreements for access to the Student Government Office shall be revoked and replaced with the procedures set forth in this order.

Any misuse of Office Space by any members of Student Government shall be deemed a violation of their applicable contract or oath of office and shall result in penalties.
