A RESOLUTION TO: AMEND THE FY17 BUDGET BY AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF FUNDS FROM THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT RESERVE ACCOUNT, THE DISCRETIONARY ACCOUNT, & THE SENATE RESOLUTION FUNDS LINE ITEM TO THE STUDENT SERVICES COMMITTEE TO BE USED FOR THE STUDENT SERVICES CAMPUS ART INITIATIVE

THE STUDENT BODY OF EASTERN MICHIGAN UNIVERSITY ENACTS:

WHEREAS, having campus art made by students will allow our campus to grow and has the potential to draw in more students;

WHEREAS, utilizing the talents of our art students will not only aid them in their careers, but also aid them financially;

WHEREAS, 2-3 students will have the opportunity to be selected via the Student Services Committee to have their art displayed on campus;

WHEREAS, Physical Plant has offered their support for displaying the art once finished and that the Head of the Art Department, Sandra Murchinson, has also offered full support;

NOTING, the authors of this resolution will collaborate to raise any further required funds in donations and that each artist will receive a small commission fee from the donated funds;

WHEREAS, all funds for this initiative will be managed by the Student Services Committee;

BE IT RESOLVED, that Student Government amends the FY17 Budget and authorizes the transfer of \$500 from the Student Government discretionary account, \$500 from the Student Government reserve account and \$1,500 from the Senate Resolution Funds line item to the Student Services Committee to be used for the Student Services Campus Art Initiative.




