Executive Order: 103-01

To ensure continued effective representation of the Eastern Michigan University Student Body, I hereby convene a Review Commission for the Student Government Bylaws to review and update the Bylaws. This commission will also be charged with reviewing and updating the Student Government Constitution, in accordance with Article V, section 6 of the Student Government Constitution.


The Review Commission shall consist of the following individuals:

- Student Body President Tanasia Morton (Voting member)
- Student Body Vice-President Joshua Starr (Voting member and Chair)
- Four appointed Senators (All voting members)
- Student Government Advisor(s) (Non-Voting member(s))
- Designated Clerk (Non-Voting member)

The four Senator positions shall be assigned upon request to the Student Body President. These will be done on a first-come first-serve basis. Considering that the Senate Currently has no Speaker and Judicial Sergeant until a special election can take place, those seats usually designated for the Speaker and Judicial Sergeant shall be filled by Senators.

The Senate will be regularly updated on the proceedings of the Commission. All meetings will be open to the public and Student Government members are encouraged to attend. Upon the conclusion of the Commission's work, any proposed changes to the Student Government Bylaws will be submitted to the Senate for approval. Any changes to the Student Government Constitution will be submitted to the Senate for approval to be put as a referendum on the March ballot.
